SKYLIGHT MAINTENANCE MANUAL

When cleaning skylights, use a soft cloth and warm soapy water.

- *Do NOT pressure wash any skylights. Pressure Washing could dislodge gaskets.
- *Do NOT use harsh abrasives
- *Do NOT stand or crawl directly on skylights.
- *Do NOT use any other chemicals for cleaning.
 - * Example: **DO NOT USE** Windex or other household cleaners.

DOME SKYLIGHT MAINTENANCE

Cleaning Acrylics

- 1) Clean with a liquid detergent such as Ivory, Joy, etc., and water. Use soft cloth, sponge and chamois. (Often surfaces can be lightly dusted with a soft clean cloth and then wiped with a soft, wet cloth or chamois).
- 2) Grease and oil spots can be removed with kerosene, **WHITE** gasoline or V.M. & P. Naptha.
- 3) Use only the above cleaning methods or approved cleaners. Other cleaners can ruin the acrylic. The following are approved cleaners:
 - A) Novus Plastic Polish
 - B) McGuire's Plastic Polish
- 4) Also for cleaning, polishing and providing an anti-static surface, the use of common household cleaner "Johnson's Pledge" is very effective.

DO NOT USE:

Window cleaning sprays (like Windex), kitchen scouring compounds or solvents such as acetone, gasoline, benzene, carbon tetrachloride or lacquer thinner.
